MCA Construction Leadership Council to Examine Construction Market Conditions

The Montana Contractors Association's Construction Leadership Council (CLC) will meet in Bozeman this month to discuss the recession of 2008 and the current U.S. bull market economy. An in-depth examination will take place comparing the differences and similarities of the two markets, and how best to prepare for the current economic climate.

Construction Markets: Lessons Learned during a Recession will take place at Riverside Country Club on Friday, November 12 from 10:30am to 3:00pm. Hosted by the MCA CLC, the format of the event will consist of two different discussion panels. Among the panels will be representation from the Bozeman area's most prominent contractors, including Tony Martel, Martel Construction, Inc.; Russ Olsen, R&R Taylor Construction, Inc.; Bill Langlas, Langlas & Associates; and Quin Williams, Williams Civil Construction. This panel, featuring Bozeman area contractors, is scheduled for 1:00pm.
